Cabinet's Charge

The mission of the AAYC Youth Leadership Cabinet is to inspire and develop young citizens in the Amarillo area to be dynamic and effective leaders committed to utilizing their talents, diversity, and creativity for the betterment of our community while supporting and helping the AAYC grow into the BEST youth center in town.

The Cabinet is administered by the youth, for the youth with some guidance from the AAYC board of directors. The youth cabinet will elect one leader as a representative to be a non-voting member of the AAYC Board of Directors that will be invited to all meetings.

The Cabinet consist of 14 voting members and 1 non-voting member-Chairman, however; these meetings are closed to only its membership. If a youth has a concern they would like the cabinet to address, please bring it to one of the members.

The AAYC Board of Directors is requesting the group to undertake these projects in 2014

1. Plan, organize and run the Amarillo Zombie Walk on Oct 11th.
2. Promo videos, pictures and ideas to let people know/learn about the AAYC and to educate about things (i.e. Say no to drugs, don't Texas and drive) Some will go on Youtube, Instagram and Facebook to help the community understand what the AAYC is and how they can get involved with us.
3. Help with our clean-up, restoral and fundraising efforts
4. Program ideas, dues and other AAYC Policy Suggestions.
5. Any other goals that the cabinet would like to tackle for the community and the AAYC as a whole.

The AAYC Board of Director's representative to oversee the youth Cabinet is LaRue Hite. Also Vee The President of the Youth Cabinet will be invited to all AAYC Board of Directors meetings and will be a member of the AAYC Advisory Board. The Youth Cabinet will always have a place on the BoD Meetings to bring up ideas, thoughts and project to the AAYC Board of Directors.

Members of the Youth Cabinet must be under the age of 18 but will be allowed to remain on the board the entire year of their 18th birthday.

The Youth Cabinet will have 3 officers: Youth Chairman, Youth Vice-Chairman, and Youth Secretary.

The Youth Cabinet will have meeting once a month. The Youth Chairman will be responsible for setting the date and time for each meeting and planning the meeting itself.
